



VIGIL HONOR NOMINATION FORM

Uh-To-Yeh-Hut-Tee Lodge

Nominees for Vigil Honor should demonstrate alertness to the needs of others and an unusual awareness of the possibilities within each situation. The Vigil Honor is the highest honor that the Order of the Arrow can bestow upon its members for service to lodge, council, and Scouting. Membership cannot be won by a person's conscious endeavors.

The Vigil Honor is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position of office to one or more of Uh-To-Yeh-Hut-Tee Lodge, the Order of the Arrow, the Scouting community and Scout Camp. Under NO circumstances should tenure in Scouting or the Order of the Arrow be considered as reason enough for a Vigil Honor nomination.

A nominee must be member of the Order of the Arrow as registered with Uh-To-Yeh-Hut-Tee Lodge and registered in Scouting; provided, that the nominee must have been a Brotherhood member for a minimum of two years.
