



GEAR LIST FOR THE ORDEAL

- Medical form - copy not original. Get it from the "Downloads" page of the lodge website, <http://uhtoyehhuttee.org>. Please fill-out and bring parts A, B and C.*
- If you are an adult, a current Youth Protection Card
- Comfortable clothes - *not a uniform that you can sleep in Friday night and work in Saturday. Wear these to registration since there may not be a time to change out of your field uniform.*
 - T-shirt - must be Scout related or have no-printing
 - Shorts or long pants – do not need to be Scout shorts/pants
 - Underwear
 - Shoes or boots
 - Socks – do not need to be Scout socks
- A sharpened pocket knife.
- Water bottle - *there are water bottles for sale in the Lodge Trading Post*
- Work gloves
- Scout cap
- Insect repellent
- Sun screen
- Sleeping bag
- Ground cloth
- Rain gear
- Jacket or sweater - if the weather might be cold
- Sleeping Pad – Adults only

Gear for Saturday Night:

- Tent and other normal camping gear for Saturday night
- Second Sleeping bag – *The one on the Ordeal could be wet with dew*
- Field uniform for the Ordeal ceremony
- Towel & wash cloth
- Toiletry kit
- Second set of underwear, socks, etc.
- Money – *for purchases at lodge trading post*

Please eat dinner before arriving at camp. You will be allowed to take nothing else with you on your Ordeal. You will spend Saturday doing various work assignments as camp service. After the work assignments are completed Saturday afternoon, you will be able to shower and clean up.

- * Please inform us in advance of dietary, medical or physical restrictions. You may be asked to leave medications with the lodge first aid official. He will be sure that you have them as needed during the weekend.
